

The overall goal of the Peter Lang Children's Trust is:

"To increase the number of babies and toddlers (aged conception to 3 years of age) in Gloucestershire who experience loving, nurturing and harm-free childhoods."

Not only will this improve the immediate experiences of childhood and parenthood, it will also provide these children with a secure emotional and social foundation for the rest of their lives and will reduce the likelihood of those later aggressive, harmful and self-destructive behaviours that result from damaging experiences in infancy. The focus is relationship between the baby and the primary caregiver (i.e. usually their mother). Programmes need to be targeted at families where significant risks to this relationship have been identified.
